The global aim is to provide an international forum for the exchange of leading edge scientific knowledge and industrial experience regarding the development and integration of the various aspects of Flexible Automation and Intelligent Manufacturing Systems covering the complete life-cycle of company's Product and Processes.

Case studies, conceptual papers, review papers, methodological papers, and multidisciplinary papers on one or more of the above topic areas are particularly welcome. All accepted papers will be published in the FAIM 2013 conference proceedings.

As in previous years, special issues of **International Journals** will be published with selected papers.

This year, we are glad to announce the inclusion of a special event - "Industrial Session" in the conference program. Here, Industrial participants will present and demonstrate solutions and on-going projects in the context of FAIM topics.
