





CREDENTIALS

The credentials created during enrolment/registration for the first time (or provided by the services in the case of teachers and technical staff) are used to access SIGARRA.

It is suggested that the user changes the password created at https://selfid.up.pt/password to activate their account in the various FCNAUP information systems and services, such as SIGARRA, email, AAI systems (federated authentication), eduroam wireless network, VPN, classroom computers and Office 365. It is recommended that users also register an alternative email address and telephone number on their institutional SIGARRA page, which, if forgotten, will help them recover their credentials.
