The deadline for the submission of abstracts for papers and posters is March 7, 2016 for the International Meeting "Recent Changes to Iberian Employment Law". Candidates must register with Congress and then send a brief summary of the paper or poster they wish to submit. The working languages are Portuguese, Spanish and English. All conference submissions will be peer reviewed.

The paper should be on one of the following topics:

Theme I: Labour reforms in Portugal and / or Spain

Theme II: Case law from the crisis

Theme III: New contractual arrangements

Theme IV: Changes in working time regulations

Theme V: Collective bargaining

### **Instructions**

A poster paper introduces initial or ongoing research, ideas and proposals to be presented, questioned or debated (a poster paper should not exceed two pages in length). Posters can be also presented.

Papers and abstracts should comply with the following rules:

- author's identity and affiliation
- title in Portuguese/Spanish/English
- abstract/resumo (150-200 words)
- 6 keywords/palavras-chave in Portuguese/Spanish/English
- papers (max. 10.000 words)
