Two of ISHCCO Aims

“To ensure that the **professional qualifications** of the health and safety construction coordinators of the countries of the National Members are acknowledged in Europe by International and European institutions”

“To safeguard and promote the **professional interests** of the health and safety construction coordinators and in particular to facilitate their free movement and establishment within Europe.”

ISHCCO Qualifications Framework - IQF

To establish a support structure to improve SHCC performance

Qualifications – knowledge, skills and attitudes

About 120 descriptors

Technician, Bachelor and Master

Be aware of the general principles of risk prevention (K)

Prepare effective information about risks (S)

Deliver information relating to SHCC risks in a suitable and effective manner (A)

Relevant for Occupational H&S protection on construction sites:

11. Sustainable Cities and Communities

12. Responsible Consumption and Production

13. Climate Action

Collective Action – example for HSCC

Knows policies that assign **responsibility** for environmental damage (e.g. "polluter pays") (K)

Can propose **alternative** pathways for sustainability (S)

Is committed to becoming an **agent of change** to achieve sustainability (A)

Individual Initiative – Example for HSCC

- Knows one's own **potential** to bring about positive environmental change (K)
- Can apply the following principles: using **fewer** resources, doing **better** with fewer resources, and **reusing** the same resources (S)
- Is confident about anticipating and influencing **sustainable** changes (A)
