Chart 1: Growth in 2003-2007 of the proportion of teachers (FTE) per category, excluding guest lecturers



Chart 2: Proportion of teachers and researchers (FTE), per gender and component unit (2007)



Chart 3: Age structure of teachers and researchers (FTE), per gender (2007)



Chart 4: Proportion of teachers and researchers (FTE), per qualifications (2007)





Chart 6: Proportion of non-teaching staff (FTE), per gender and component unit (2007)



Chart 7: Age structure of non-teaching staff (FTE), per gender (2007)



Chart 8: Proportion of non-teaching staff (FTE), per professional group (2007)


