- a) Holders of a Bachelor's degree (Licenciatura) or legal equivalent.
- b) Holders of a foreign academic degree awarded as result of the completion of a 1st cycle of studies organized according to the principles of the Bologna Process by a State complying with this process;
- c) Holders of a foreign academic degree that is recognized as meeting the objectives of a 1st cycle degree by the competent scientific body of the higher education institution where they wish to be admitted to.
