## Access conditions and criteria for selection and ranking

#### Specific conditions to access the cycle of studies

The following may apply for this cycle of studies:

- a) Holders of a Bachelor's degree or legal equivalent, more specifically: 1 holders of a Bachelor's degree (1st cycle of Bologna) in the area of Information Science or other considered adequate by the Master's scientific committee; 2 exceptionally, in duly justified cases, the scientific committee of the Master's Programme may admit candidates with a degree in another area. In these cases, the candidate will be required to have obtained approval in a set of first-cycle courses (up to a maximum of 30 ECTS) in the scientific area they are applying to;
- b) Holders of a foreign Higher Education degree conferred after a first cycle of studies structured in accordance with the Bologna Process by a State that implemented this process, with the specificities referred to in a);
- c) Holders of a foreign Higher Education degree that is recognized as meeting the objectives of a Bachelor's degree by the Master's scientific committee, with the specificities referred to in a);
- d) Those with an academic, scientific or professional curriculum recognized as attesting to their ability to carry out this cycle of studies by the Master's scientific committee.

Relevant professional experience – Relevance of the role for Information Science, type and duration of the position held.	15%
