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Specific conditions to access the cycle of studies

The following may apply for this cycle of studies:

- Holders of a Bachelor's degree (Licenciatura) or equivalent in Civil Engineering, Environmental Engineering, Architecture, Geographic Engineering, Land Planning or related fields. Holders of a Bachelor's degree or equivalent of cycles of studies that require the subject of Mathematics A for application to Higher Education can also apply;
- Holders of a foreign higher education degree awarded after a 1st cycle of studies in an appropriate area (Civil Engineering, Environmental Engineering, Architecture, Geographic Engineering, Land Planning, or related fields) organized in accordance with the Bologna Process by a State that implemented this process, or that is recognized as meeting the objectives of a Bachelor's degree by the statutorily competent scientific body;
- Those with an academic, scientific or professional curriculum recognized by the competent scientific body as attesting to their capacity to carry out this cycle of studies.

Criteria and sub-criteria for selection and ranking of applicants	
 1 - Academic curriculum - the academic degree is evaluated based on the following sub-criteria: a. Holding a 3-year degree in Civil Engineering, Environmental Engineering, Architecture, Geographic Engineering, Land Planning or related fields: 140 points (on a scale from 0 to 200) b. Holding a 5-year degree (Pre-Bologna Licenciado Degree, Integrated Master or equivalent) in Civil Engineering, Environmental Engineering, Architecture, Geographic Engineering, Land Planning or related fields: 200 points (on a scale from 0 to 200) 	20%
2 - Final numerical grade of the degree defined in 1., expressed on a scale from 0 to 200. In the case of international students, the final numerical grade of the degree defined in 1. will be adjusted in order to correspond to an evaluation criterion on a scale from 0 to 200.	30%
3 - The average of ECTS credits achieved in the curricular units considered more relevant for the cycle of studies.	20%
 4 - Behavioural and social skills evaluated by curriculum vitae (on a scale from 0 to 200): (i) - Motivation and social performance directly related with the scientific field of the cycle of studies; (ii) - Relevant social initiatives, including volunteering and direct involvement in key causes of the global society. The total in this Criterion 4 may not exceed 200 points. 	30%

Applicants tie-breaking criterion

If there is a tie, priority will be given to the applicant with a higher classification in Criterion 2.

If this criterion is not sufficient, tie-break will be done based on Criterion 3.
