Specific conditions to access the cycle of studies

The following may apply for this cycle of studies:

- Holders of a Bachelor's (Licenciatura) degree or legal equivalent that is recognized as attesting the capacity to carry out this cycle of studies by the respective Scientific Committee;
- Holders of a foreign higher academic degree bestowed following a 1st cycle of studies organized according to the principles of the Bologna process by an acceding State to this process, and that is recognized as attesting the capacity to carry out this cycle of studies by the respective Scientific Committee;
- Holders of a foreign higher academic degree that is recognised as meeting the objectives of the Bachelor's degree by the Scientific Committee of the cycle of studies;
- Those with an academic, scientific or professional curriculum that is recognized as attesting the capacity to carry out this cycle of studies by the respective Scientific Committee.

Criteria and sub-criteria for selection and ranking of applicants

Academic qualification Previous academic path is assessed according to the relevance of the degree, the final grade(s) of the degree(s) and the weighted average of the ECTS credits regarding curricular units considered relevant for this cycle of studies.	85%
Professional career This is assessed taking into consideration its relevance for the cycle of studies and the number of years of professional activity.	10%
Behavioural and relational skills	2,5%
Motivation Letter of motivation and any letters of recommendation, regarding motivation and capacity, complemented by a possible interview*, if deemed necessary.	2,5%
