They replace the pencil with the photographic camera, as a device for thinking, drawing, perceiving, and diagnosing the natural and built space, whose actions are regulated by the Diário do Espacialista and assisted by the "Espacialist Por/tactile Kit" that they carry with them. Os Espacialistas go towards space, aware that the thought that counts is the one that walks and that geometry is the relationship of affection that the Human Being establishes with Nature, ready to measure the real and imaginary intensities between the body measurements (S, M, L, XL) and space situations (X,Y,Z) found, from the body of each one or with the help of i-material objects that they find in the places where they pass and that they intentionally carry with them as metric systems of measurement and weight of intensities.

The photographic sketches resulting from this intense activity of making mistakes while walking, turned into a performative drawing and an architectural gesture, are a kind of minimal units of counting and inhabiting, constructions on the scale of the memory and imagination of those who live in them, in the *Heideggerian* sense of building and thinking.

A Spatialist Photographic Sketch is a narrative-house under construction, in the form of a story-telling machine, subject to all kinds of conversations and projections, that each one in contact with it is able to make it appear, project physically and psychically, transforming it at every moment into a potential shelter for the exercise of new dialogues and configurations of imagination of memory and thought.


