Stage 4: May 20 to May 31, Confirming with European experts

After communicating with and listening to the suggestions of the European civil engineering experts Prof. Giuliano Augusti and Prof. Alfredo Soeiro, the Chinese panel, headed by its chief professor, has set up an indicator system based on the integration of European suggestions and Chinese opinions while seeking common ground and putting aside difference, and has won recognition from both domestic and European partners.

Stage 5: June 1 to July 5, Technological cooperation

Having submitted the indicator system and information about partners through coordination with other subject areas; having several times of communication with Dr. Pablo, who is responsible for European technology related affairs, for sake of guaranteeing the online questionnaires are opened in time.

Stage 6: July 6 to July 8, Screening questionnaire object and beginning paper survey

Under the guidance of project office, each subject area screening its own four types of questionnaire objects, building tracing archive, inviting and confirming objects. According to European requirements, the number of questionnaire shall be no less than 400; and we are doing it with the number of 600. After confirming the delay of European partners' online survey, we began the paper questionnaire survey at the middle of June, and have already collected part of the paper.

Stage 7: Aug. 10 to Aug. 25, Questionnaire data analysis

Stage 8: Aug. 25 to Sep. 15, Holding the second China-Europe expert seminar, where the Chinese panel carrying out comparative analysis on the data and comparing with European analytical methods.

Stage 9: Sep. 15 to Nov. 5, Drawing up Chinese research report

Stage 10: Nov. 5 to Dec. 30, Revising Chinese report; holding the third China-Europe expert seminar; finalizing the report based on European experts' suggestions.

From January 2014, starting surveying on the application of Phase 1 research achievements in the member institutes, the acceptance due in March 2014 as anticipated.
