Master in Academic and Clinical Education

A – Specific conditions for accessing the study cycle

According to the general regulations for the 2nd and 3rd study cycles of UPorto, the SC Scientific Committee is responsible for this information and it is subject to approval by the Faculty Director. However, this does not apply to study cycles merged with other University Institutions, to which the principles defined in the respective collaboration agreement apply, as well as in the specific regulations of the study cycle, formulated according to the Legal Regime of Degrees and Diplomas of Higher Education (DL 65/2018, of 16th August).

Whenever possible, the scientific areas of the qualifications required for the application should be mentioned.

Specific conditions for accessing the study cycle

- a) Holders of the degree of Bachelor / Master or legal equivalent in the areas of Health and Life Sciences (including Psychology).
- b) Holders of a foreign higher academic degree in Health and Life Sciences (including Psychology) conferred following a 1st cycle of studies organized according to the principles of the studies organized according to the principles of the Bologna Process by a State adhering to this Process.
- c) Holders of an academic, scientific or professional curriculum vitae that is recognized as attesting the capacity to carry out this cycle of studies by the statutorily competent scientific board of the academic institution where they intend to be admitted.

B – Criteria and sub criteria for selection and serialization of candidates

Selection and serialization criteria should be defined using clear, objective and easily applicable and justifiable parameters in order to safeguard the transparency and rigor of the applications' evaluation.

The assessment of criteria and sub-criteria measured by a numerical scale allows a more objective evaluation of the potential and academic/ scientific / artistic / professional skills and capacity of the candidates.

B – Criteria and sub criteria for selection and serialization of candidates	
A) SCHOOL, SCIENTIFIC OR PROFESSIONAL CURRICULUM (Weighting: 60%; Max. 12 points)	
Undergraduate and graduate training * (max. 4 points)	
Holders of Bachelor / Master's degree or legal equivalent in the areas of Health and Life Sciences (including Psychology) and / or graduates with other training, after hearing the Master's Scientific Committee, with a final average equal to or greater than 14 points (scale 0-20).	4 points
Holders of Bachelor / Master's degree or legal equivalent in the areas of Health and Life Sciences (including Psychology) and / or graduates with other training, after hearing the Master's Scientific Committee, with a final average of less than 14 points.	3 points
Scientific Experience * (max. 4 points)	
One or more publication (fully written by the candidate)	4 points
One or more publications in the form of oral communication, poster or abstract	2 points
No full-length publication, oral communication, poster or abstract	1 point
Professional Experience * (max. 4 points)	
Professional experience relevant to the study cycle, less than 1 year	2 points
Professional experience relevant to the study cycle, between 1 and 2 years	3 points
Professional experience relevant to the attendance of the Cycle of Studies, for more than 2 years	4 points
B) SELECTION'S INTERVIEW (Weighting: 40 %; Max. 8 points)	
Aspects to be evaluated in the selection interview	
Motivation for attending the study cycle	Up to 2 points
Demonstration of ability to complete the degree	Up to 2 points
Previous knowledge of the programmatic contents	Up to 2 points
Performance/overall assessment of the candidate, namely professional attitude, contact and communication skills, as well as other characteristics that the Scientific Committee considers relevant	Up to 2 points

Tie-breaking criterion for candidates (may be the classification in some of the elements of the previous table)
