On the occasion of the 98th EGPRN Meeting to be held in Porto, Portugal "<u>The International Web-based Course on Research in Primary Health Care</u>" online modules are offered to all Portuguese free of charge.

The course is suitable for general practitioners and other primary care doctors and other healthcare related professionals interested in research and it is designed

- To help participants to design a research question.
- To give participants a basic understanding of research methods and biostatistics.
- To give practical experience of development of study protocols and applications for research funding.
- To give practical experience of use of computers for database manipulation, use of spread-sheets and statistical analysis.

You can obtain the full certificate

after completing the online modules and participat-

ing in a final workshop where you will be asked to make a brief presentation of your own project of research (max 10 slides - 10 minutes) at the EGPRN Porto Meeting. After your presenta-

tion there will be a discussion with the course moderators and the other participants

You can join the EGPRN Porto Meeting to do your final research project presentation and get your certificate. EGPRN offers a reduced registration, it is only €100 for the web-based course presenters.

The EGPRN Porto meeting will be held at the The Faculty of Medicine of the University of Porto (FMUP) between 9-12 May 2024.

Please let us know of your intention to make a presentation at the upcoming Porto meeting **until 2 February 2024** by writing to office@egprn.org and we will reserve a spot for you. You will later be expected to upload your abstract by 11 February.
