

Justification of the application /motivation letter

Applicants must present a document that justifies their interest in attending and completing the master degree and that, simultaneously, indicates the field of research to be undertaken, as well as its relevance to the production of knowledge in Adult Education. *This document must have between 1 and 3 A4 pages.*

Curriculum Vitae

I – Identification

Name, date of birth, address, phone, mobile phone, e-mail

II – Academic qualifications

Academic path in Higher Education stating: degrees, fields of specialization (if any), final grade and year of completion.

III – Further education

Good knowledge of English and French and other language (must indicate the level: excellent, good, basic).

Training in areas directly or indirectly related to the theme of Master, with chronological ordering of the information provided and mention the duration and promoter.

IV – Lifelong learning

Personal experiences, professional, socially relevant, or its products – in the form of portfolio - as a source of informal and non-formal learning.

V – Professional Experience

Presentation of the professional trajectory in chronological order, where appropriate.

VI – Participation in intervention projects or intervention activities

Specification of projects and/or activities (length, financed or non-financed) and the type of involvement (as organizer, facilitator, team member,...).

VII – Involvement in research projects

Specification of projects (length, financed or non-financed) and the type of involvement (as organizer, facilitator, team member,...).

VIII – Participation in scientific meetings with presentation of communications (conferences, seminars, symposiums)

Mention of the organizing bodies and the titles of the presentations, in chronological order.

IX – Publications

Reference of publications with details of authorship/co-authorship, date, title, type of publication (book, magazine, book chapter, other,...), edition (publisher, newspaper, magazine) and number of pages.
