Professor Guntram Schernthaner is a clinical diabetologist with a special interest in the prevention and treatment of vascular diseases, new therapeutic strategies for type 2 diabetes, metabolic surgery and immunointervention of type 1 diabetes. He is involved in many International Guidelines as author or as official reviewer for diabetes, pre-diabetes, and cardiovascular diseases and has published more than 350 papers in leading journals listed in PubMed. He has led more than 40 studies such as the Canadian-Cyclosporin Trial, the Diapep277 Study, the IDNT, IRMA2, QUARTET, PROactive, STOPNIDDM, GUIDE, ORIGIN, LEAD-6, DIRECT, EUREXA, DURATION 6, GENERATION etc; and has been the lecturer of International Societies including: ADA, EASD, EDTA/ERA, IDF, European Society of Hypertension, European Society of Endocrinology, European Society of Obesity, International Society of Kidney Diseases, International Society of Cardiology, Chinese Society of Diabetes, and CODHY International. He has maintained international scientific cooperation with more than 40 Universities in Europe, USA, Australia, Canada, Japan and Brasil.
