A – Specific access conditions to the cycle of studies

May apply to the Master Degree in Marine Sciences - Marine Resources (MCMRM) holders of bachelor degree or legal equivalent in Life Sciences field. Are also admissible applicants in other conditions, namely under Article 17, of Decree-Law No.74/2006, as amended by Decree-Law No.65/2018. In this context, may apply any person who holds an academic, scientific or professional curriculum that is recognized as certifying capacity to perform the cycle of studies, at the time of the application's analysis by the scientific commission of the cycle of studies, according to the admission criteria and sub criteria which are annually defined and announced publicly.

B – Criteria and sub criteria of applicant's selection and seriation

1 » CV's assessment, with points allocation from 0 to 20. In the assessment are considered adequacy and merit of academic training and of potential professional path of the applicant, as well as the possible existence of technical and scientific gains and other relevant gains in the context. The detailed analysis is made by the Scientific Commission of the Master and it will be poured in Minutes, available to applicants. Sub criteria weighting (0 to 20 points for item) is made according to: [ACADEMIC MERIT x **70%**] + [SCIENTIFIC GAINS (author/co-author of publications in indexed journals in Scopus x 25%; author/co-author in publications in journals non indexed in Scopus x 25%; author/co-author in communications at congresses/ scientific meetings x 25%; merit awards x 25%) x **15%**] + [OTHER GAINS relevant in the context of personal merit appreciation (actions on behalf of the community x 25%; professional path richness x 25%; participation in sportive activities x 25%, other non-considered previously x 25%) x **15%**].

2 » Assessment of Applicant's Motivation, with points from 0 to 20. Made the analysis of the Application Motivation Letter (classification from 0 to 20) x **70%** + Video of Personal Presentation (maximum 2 min) (classification from 0 to 20) x **30%**.
