Master Degree in Oncology

**A – Specific access conditions to the cycle of studies**

According to the general regulations of 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> cycles of UPorto this information is responsibility of the CS Scientific Commission, being subject of approval by the Faculty Director. Exception is made to the cycles of studies conjoint with others Higher Education Institutions, to which is applied the principles defined in the corresponding cooperation agreement, as well as in the specific regulation of cycle of studies made accordingly to the Legal Regime on Academic Degrees and Higher Education Diplomas (DL 65/2018 of 16 August).

When possible it should be mentioned the scientific areas of the qualifications demanded for application.

**Specific access conditions to the cycle of studies**

It can apply to Master Degree in Oncology (MO) those who assemble the following conditions, according to art. 17 of DL No 74/2006, as amended by DL No 65/2018:

- Holder of bachelor degree or legal equivalent in Medicine, Dental Medicine, Veterinary Medicine, Biology, Biochemistry, Pharmaceutical Sciences, Nursing, Psychology, Health Technology and other bachelors degree or legal equivalent in health sciences areas with interest in oncology, with minimum grade of 14 values;
- Holder of foreign university degree according to subparagraphs c) and d) of the mentioned article in one of the areas described in the preceding subparagraph with minimum grade of 14 values;
- It could be admitted bachelor degrees with a grade lower than 14 values, after curriculum assessment made by the scientific commission as long as it is recognised as adequate the academic, scientific or professional curriculum that certify capacity to fulfil the cycle of studies.

**B – Criteria and sub criteria of applicant's selection and seriation**

Selection and seriation criteria must be defined using clear, assertive and easy application and justification variables, to safeguard transparency and accuracy of application's evaluation.

Criteria and sub criteria assessment measured through a numerical scale allows an evaluation more assertive of applicant's academic/ scientific/ artistic/ professional potential and capacity.

The final classification will result on the sum of points from 1 to 5.

In case the selection jury finds necessary it can be made contact with the applicant in order to clarify less obvious items.

**Applicant's tiebreaker criteria (*can be the ranking of some elements of the previous table*)**

In case of tie on the final vacancies it will be considered the more recent date of bachelor degree acquisition.

If, applied all the previous criteria, there is still a tie it is considered the number of scientific works published.
