1. Metodologia do QS WUR e participação da U.Porto

“ The 21st edition of the QS World University Rankings features over 1,500 institutions and is the only ranking of its kind to emphasise employability and sustainability.

The results draw on the analysis of 17.5m academic papers and the expert opinions of over 240,000 academic faculty and employers. Massachusetts Institute of Technology celebrates thirteen years at the top, while Imperial College London has climbed to second place.

Since our 2024 edition, we have incorporated three new indicators into the QS World University Ranking.

Sustainability

Sustainability has become a touchpoint for global institutions as they come to realise their impact on the world, and students have come to expect institutions to tackle issues related to social and climate justice.

We have recognised this call to action by adding a five percent weight Sustainability lens to our flagship world ranking, the first of the major rankings to do so to reflect the crucial role universities play in charting the course and driving change towards a more sustainable future.

Employment outcomes

We have also continued to strengthen our insight on employability and remain the only major ranking to enshrine the importance of employability in our methodology. To do this, we have boosted the weight of Employer Reputation to 15 percent and added Employment Outcomes at five percent.

International research network

Our third new metric, International Research Network, is another way of recognising the importance of research in changing the world. This metric specifically provides insight on how internationally connected an institution's research is as well as recognising the importance of collaborative research more broadly.

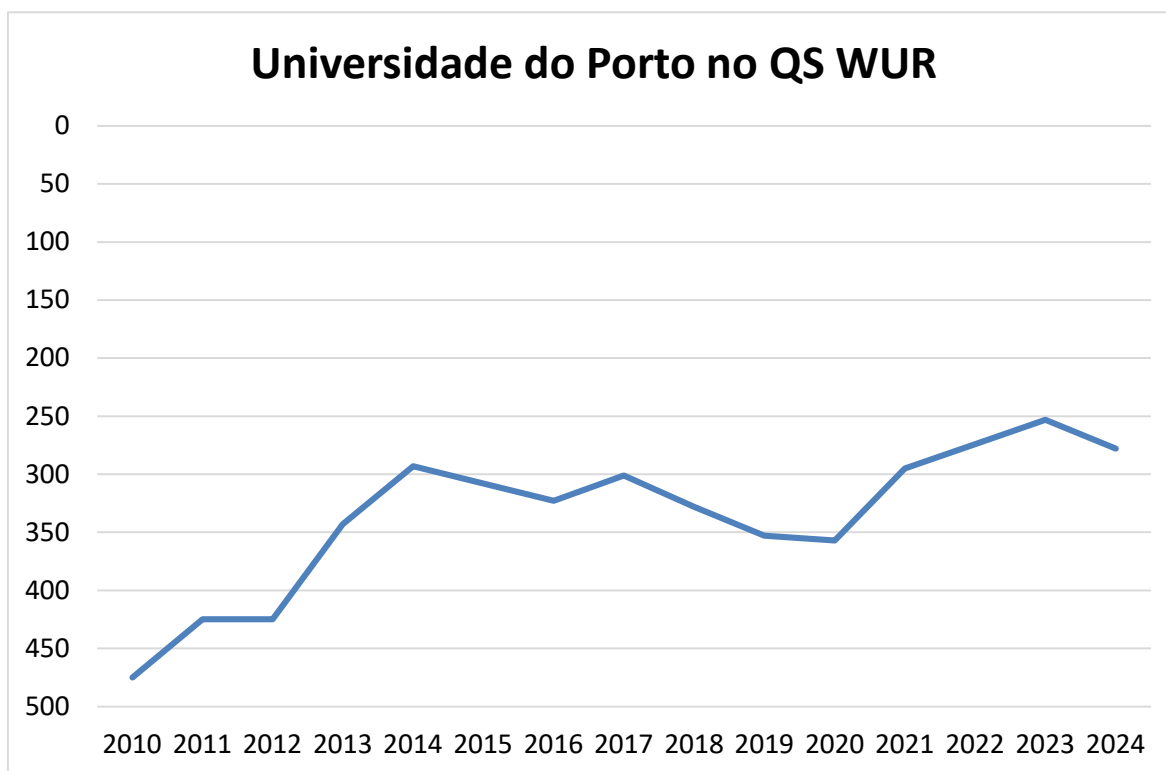


Figura 1: Evolução da posição da Universidade do Porto no QS WUR

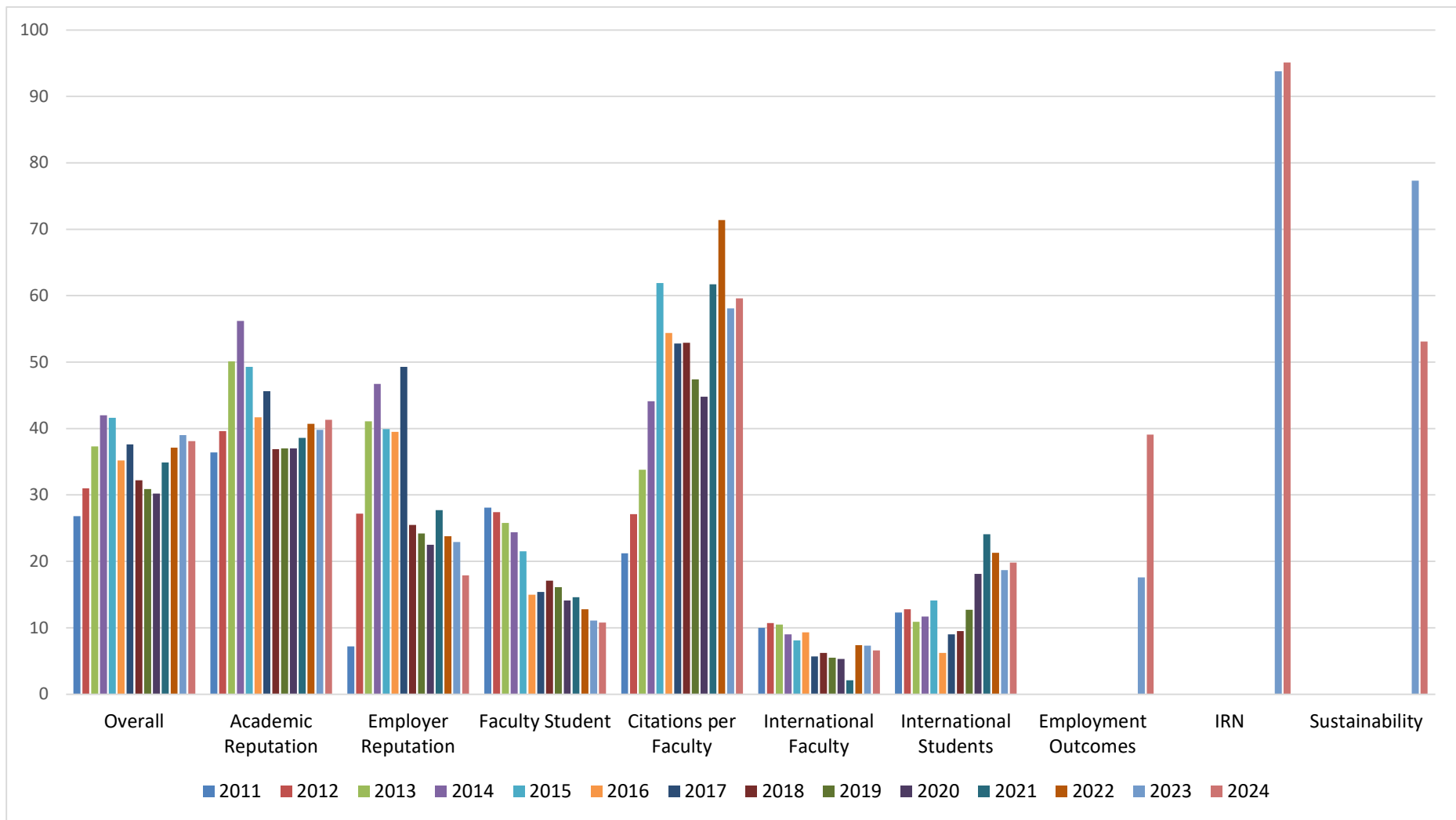


Figura 2: Evolução dos scores da Universidade do Porto no QS WUR entre 2011 e 2024

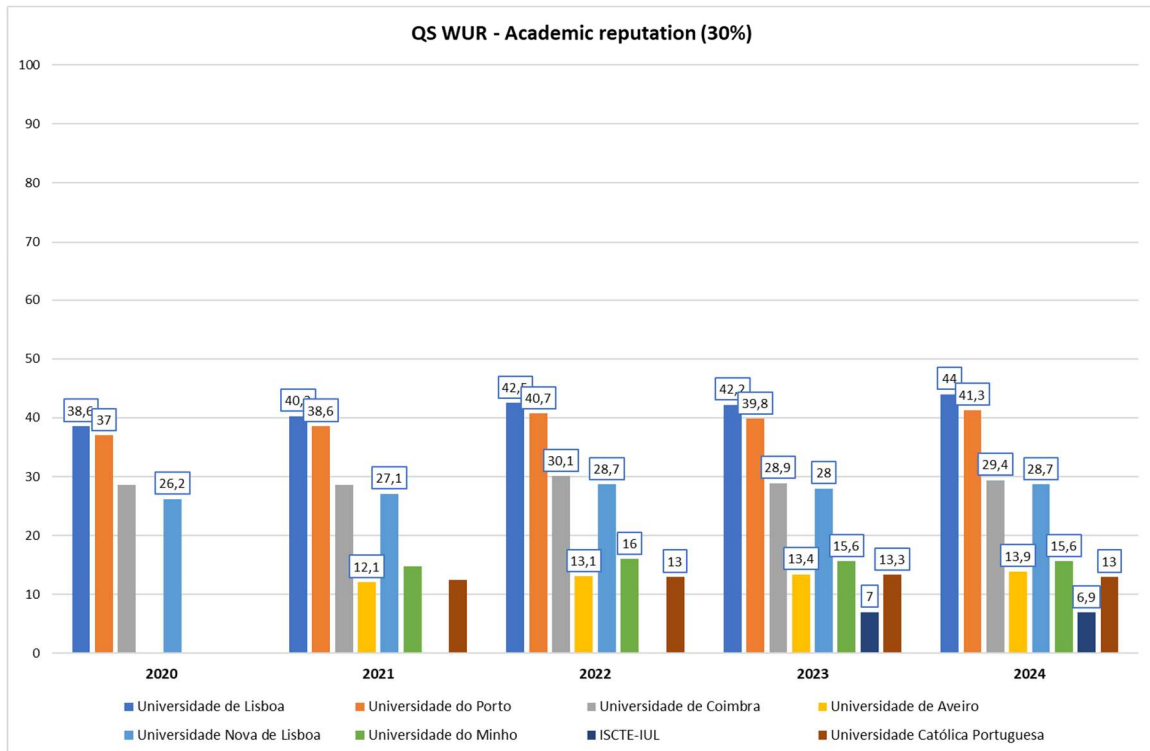


Figura 3: Scores das universidades portuguesas em *Academic reputation* no QS WUR: evolução 5 anos

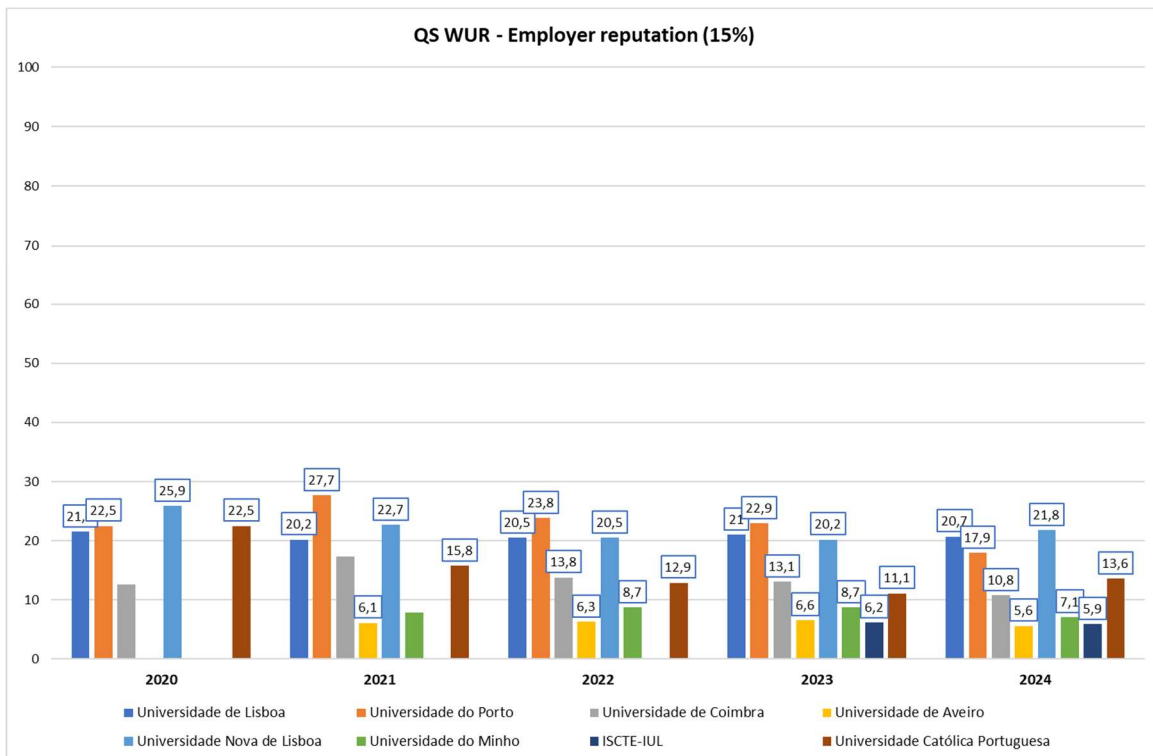


Figura 4: Scores das universidades portuguesas em *Employer reputation* no QS WUR: evolução 5 anos

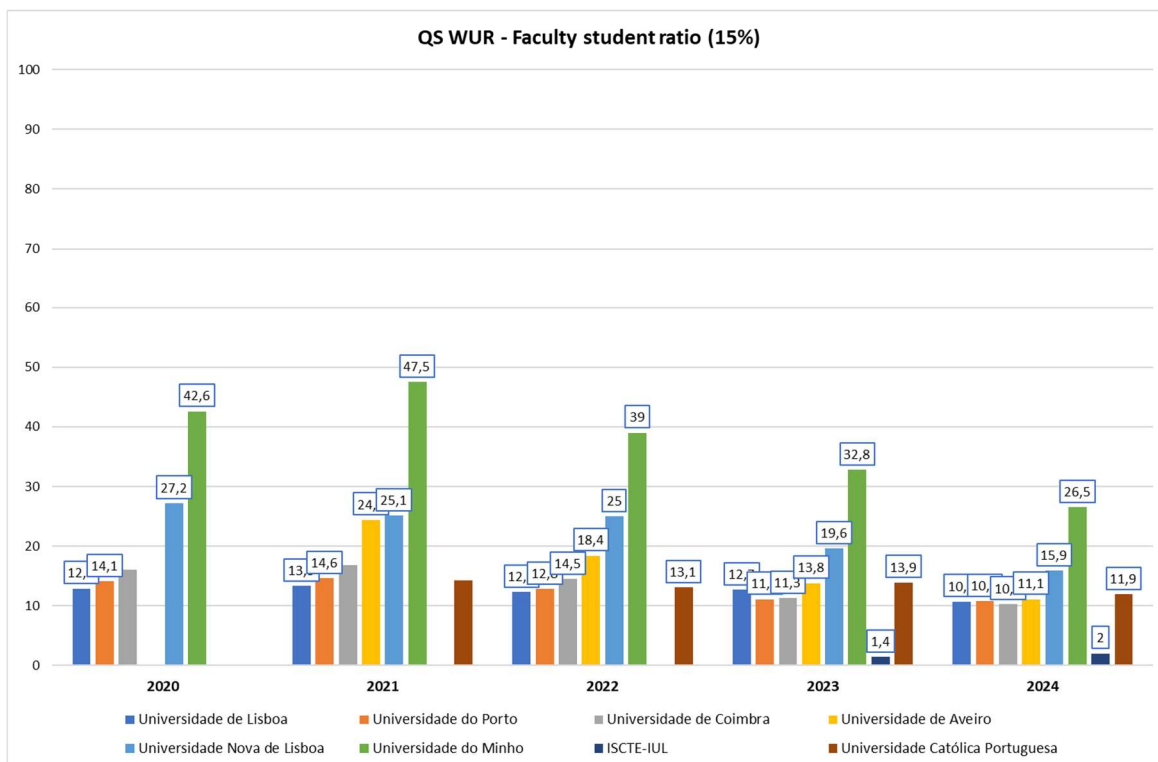


Figura 5: Scores das universidades portuguesas em *Faculty student ratio* no QS WUR: evolução 5 anos

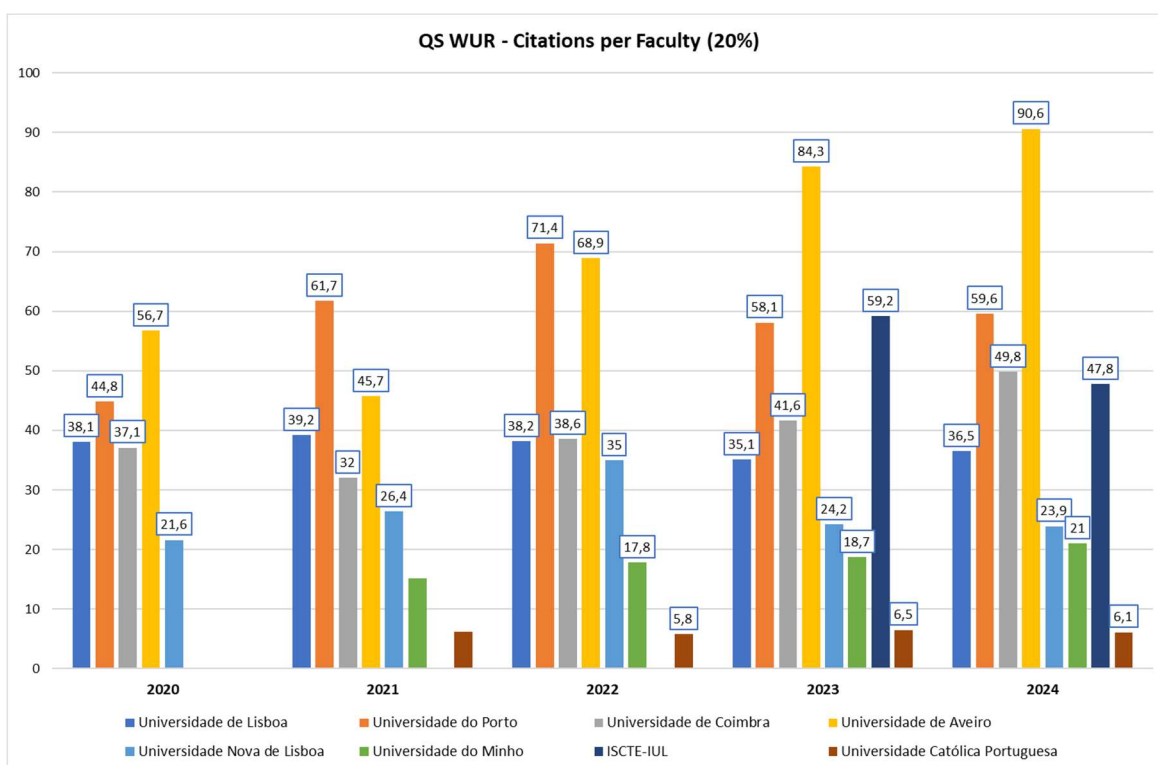


Figura 6: Scores das universidades portuguesas em *Citations per Faculty* no QS WUR: evolução 5 anos

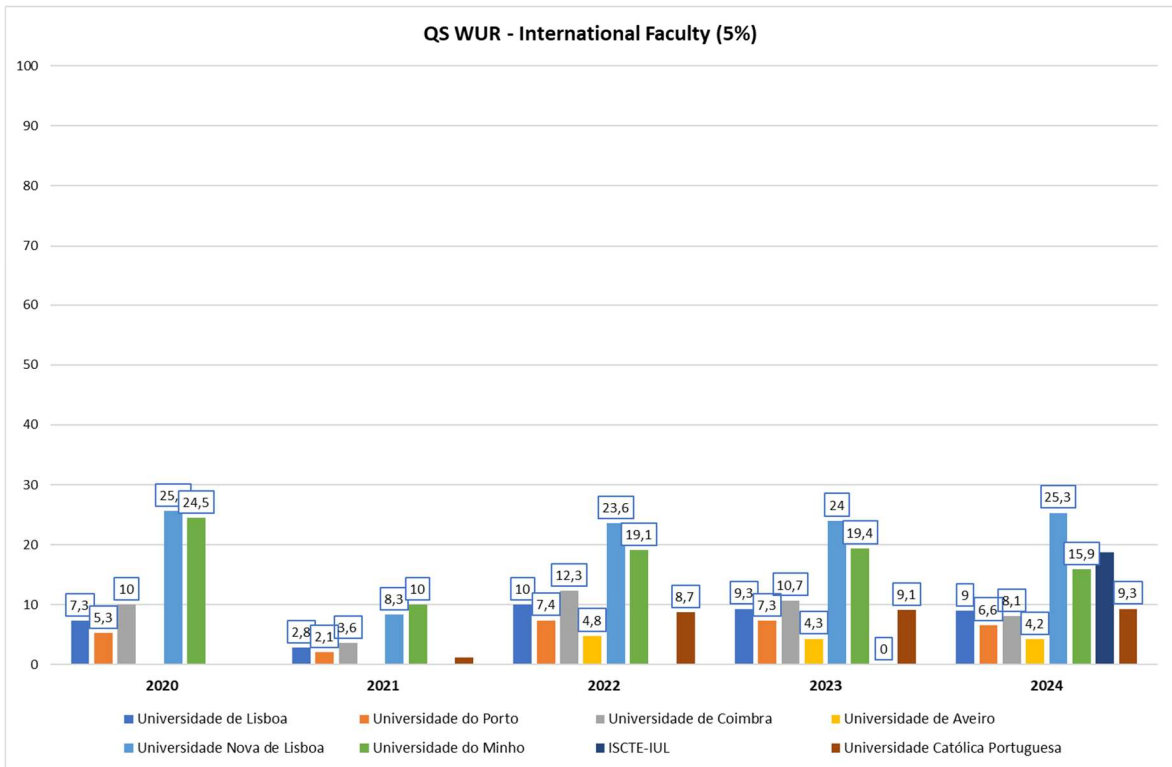


Figura 7: Scores das universidades portuguesas em *International Faculty* no QS WUR: evolução 5 anos

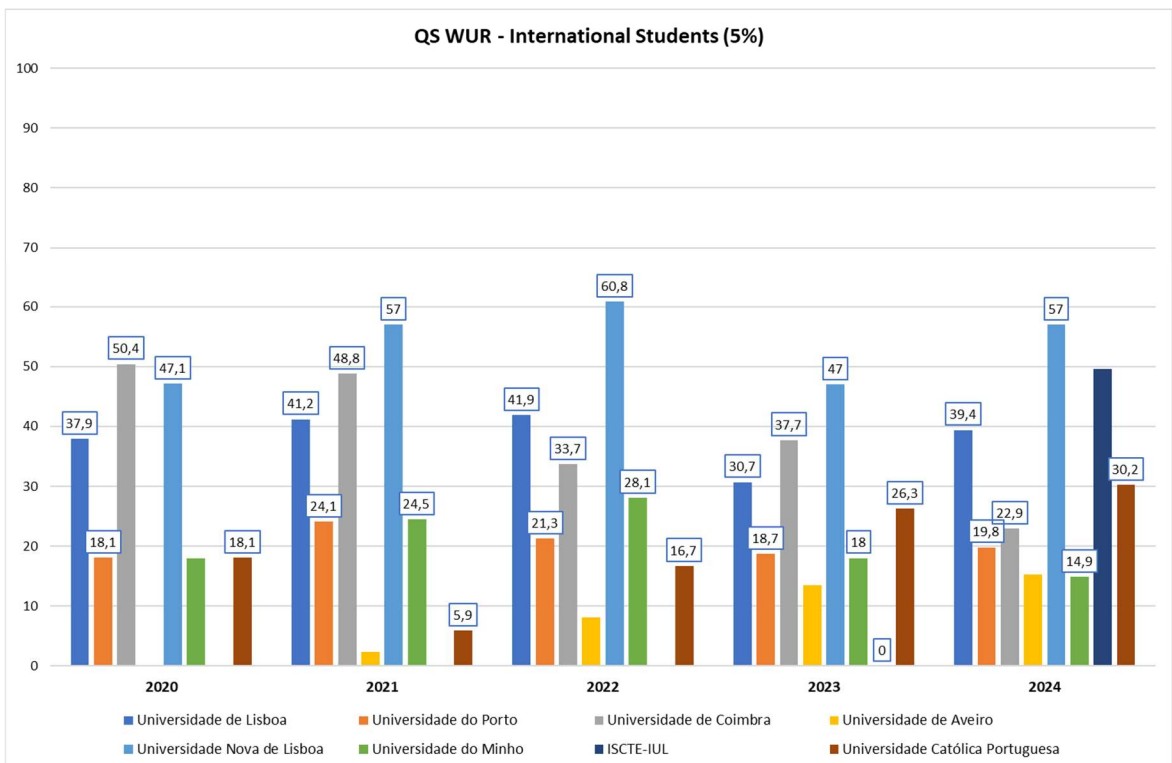


Figura 8: Scores das universidades portuguesas em *International Students* no QS WUR: evolução 5 anos

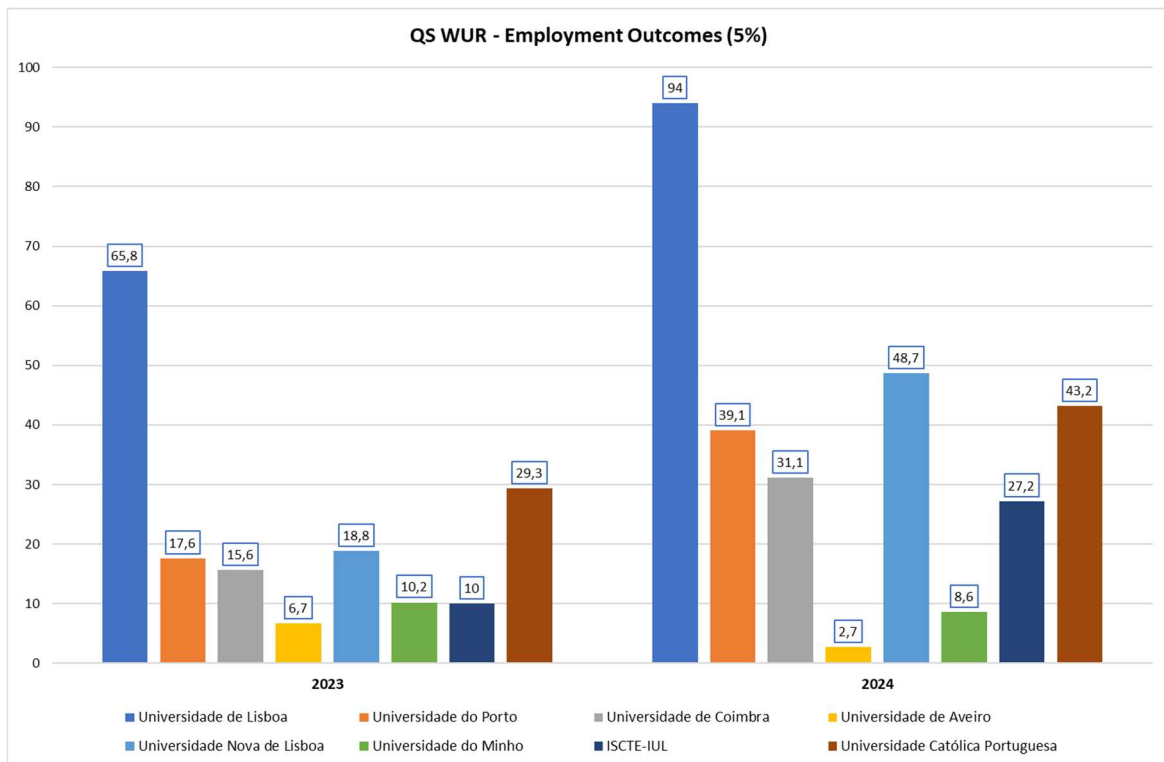


Figura 9: Scores das universidades portuguesas em *Employment Outcomes* no QS WUR: 2023 e 2024

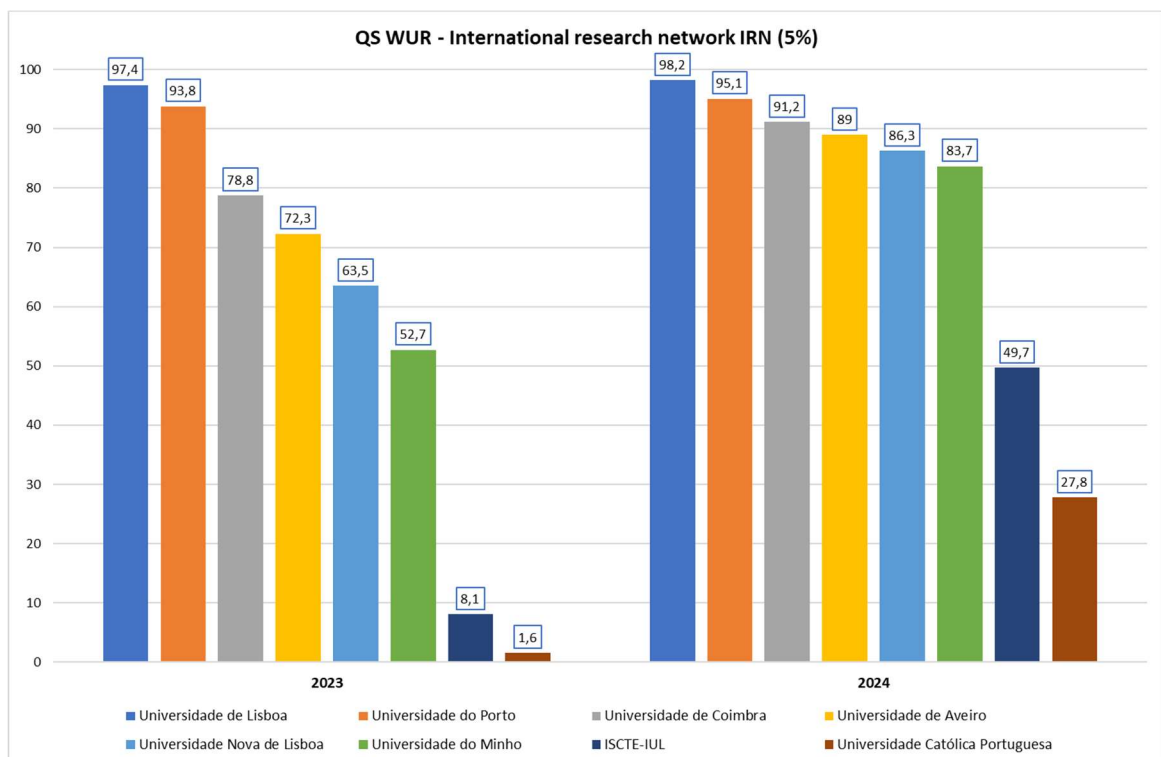


Figura 10: Scores das universidades portuguesas em *International research network* no QS WUR: 2023 e 2024

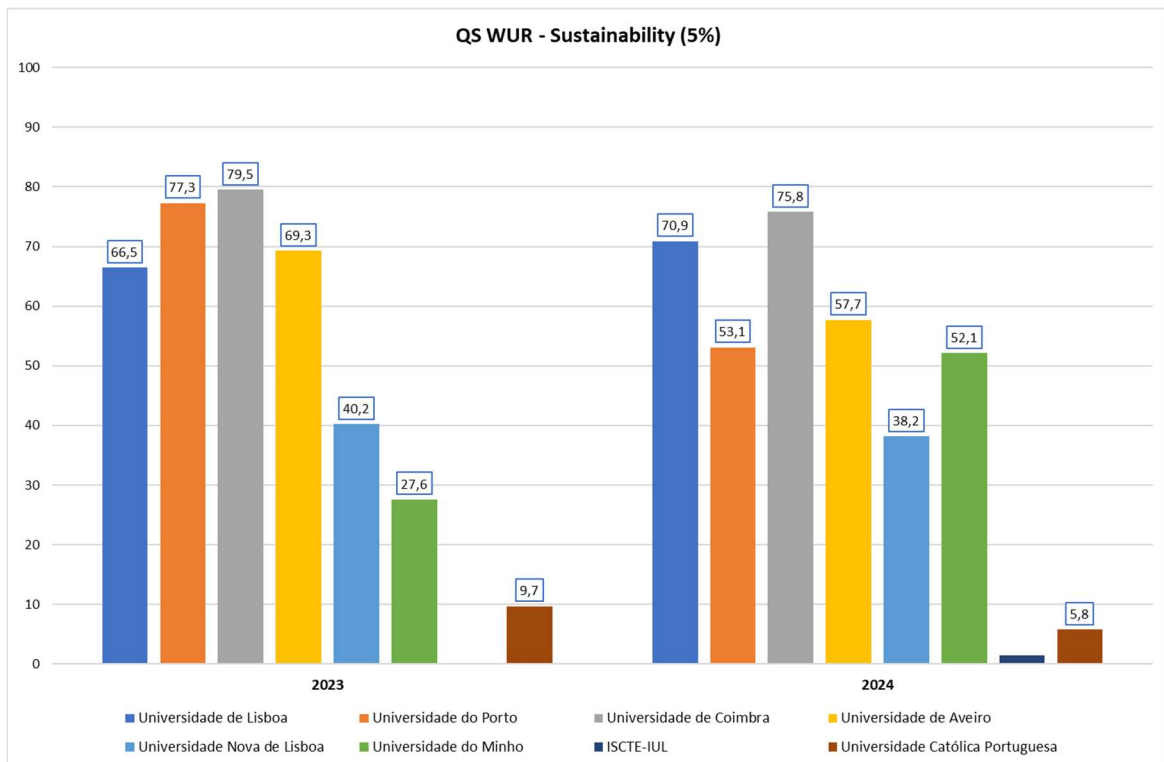


Figura 11: *Sustainability* das universidades portuguesas no QS WUR: 2023 e 2024

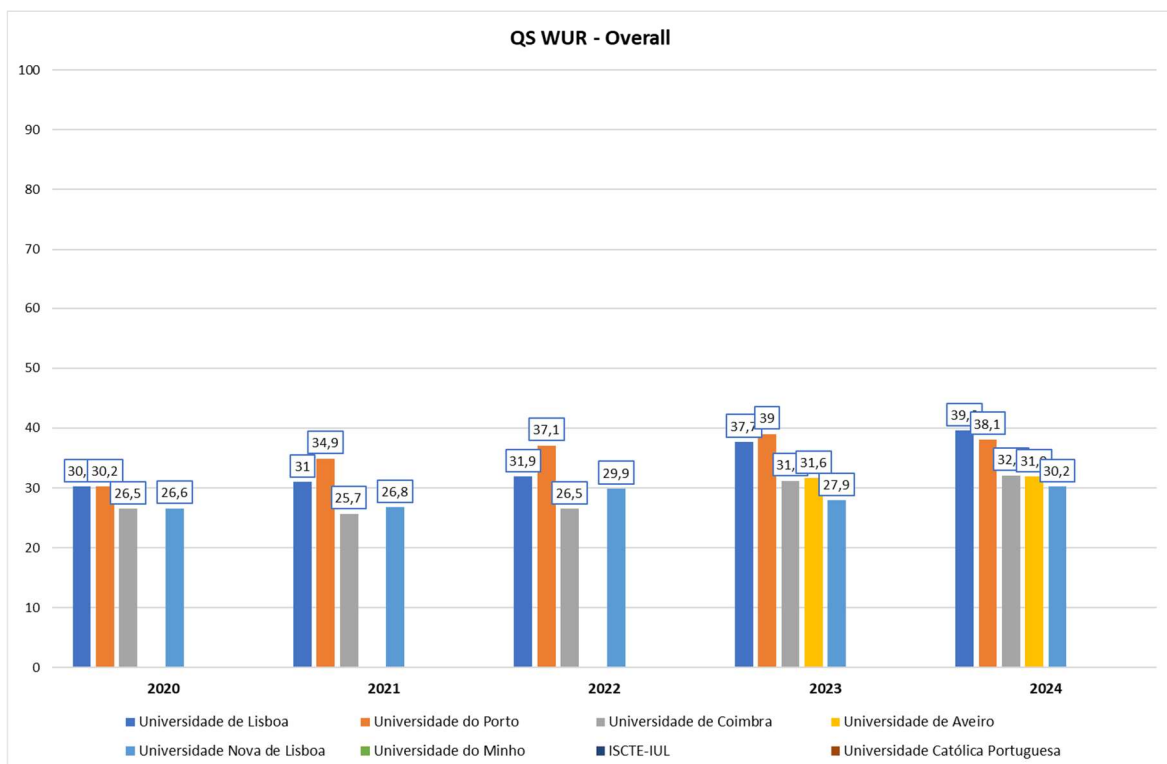


Figura 12: *Overall score* das universidades portuguesas no QS WUR: evolução 5 anos

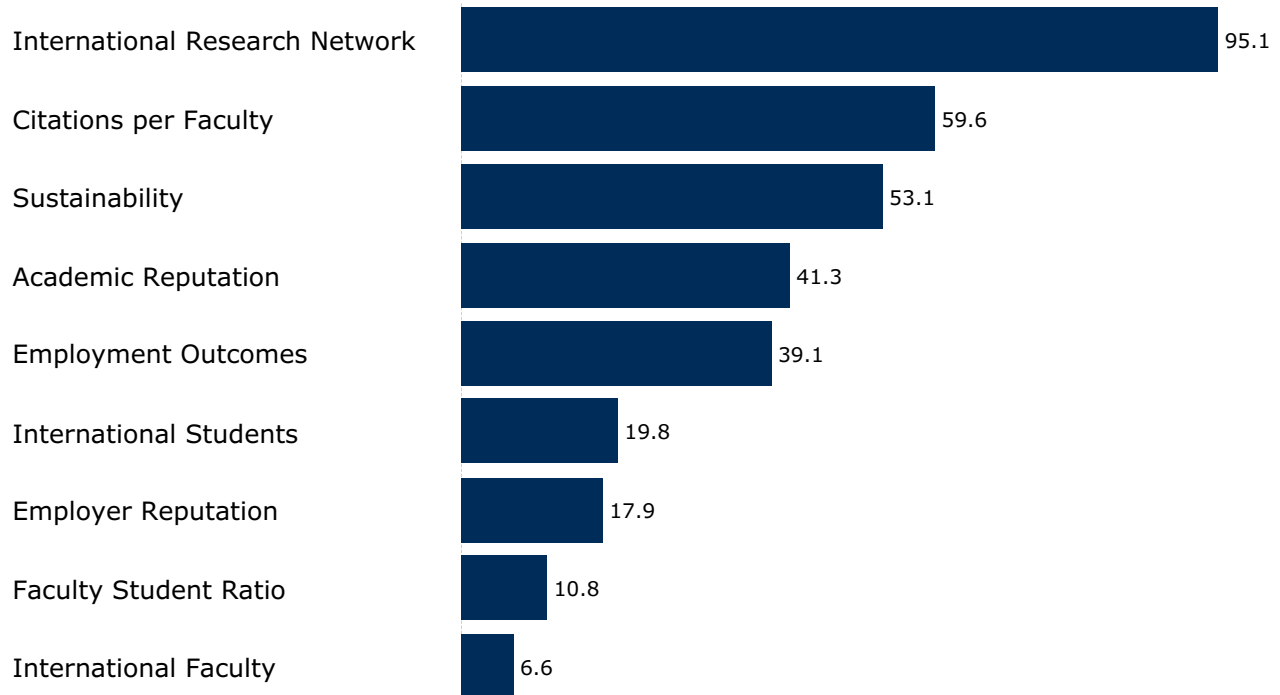

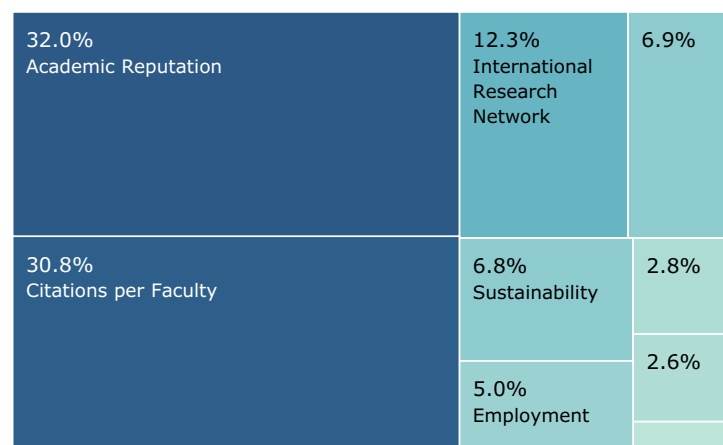

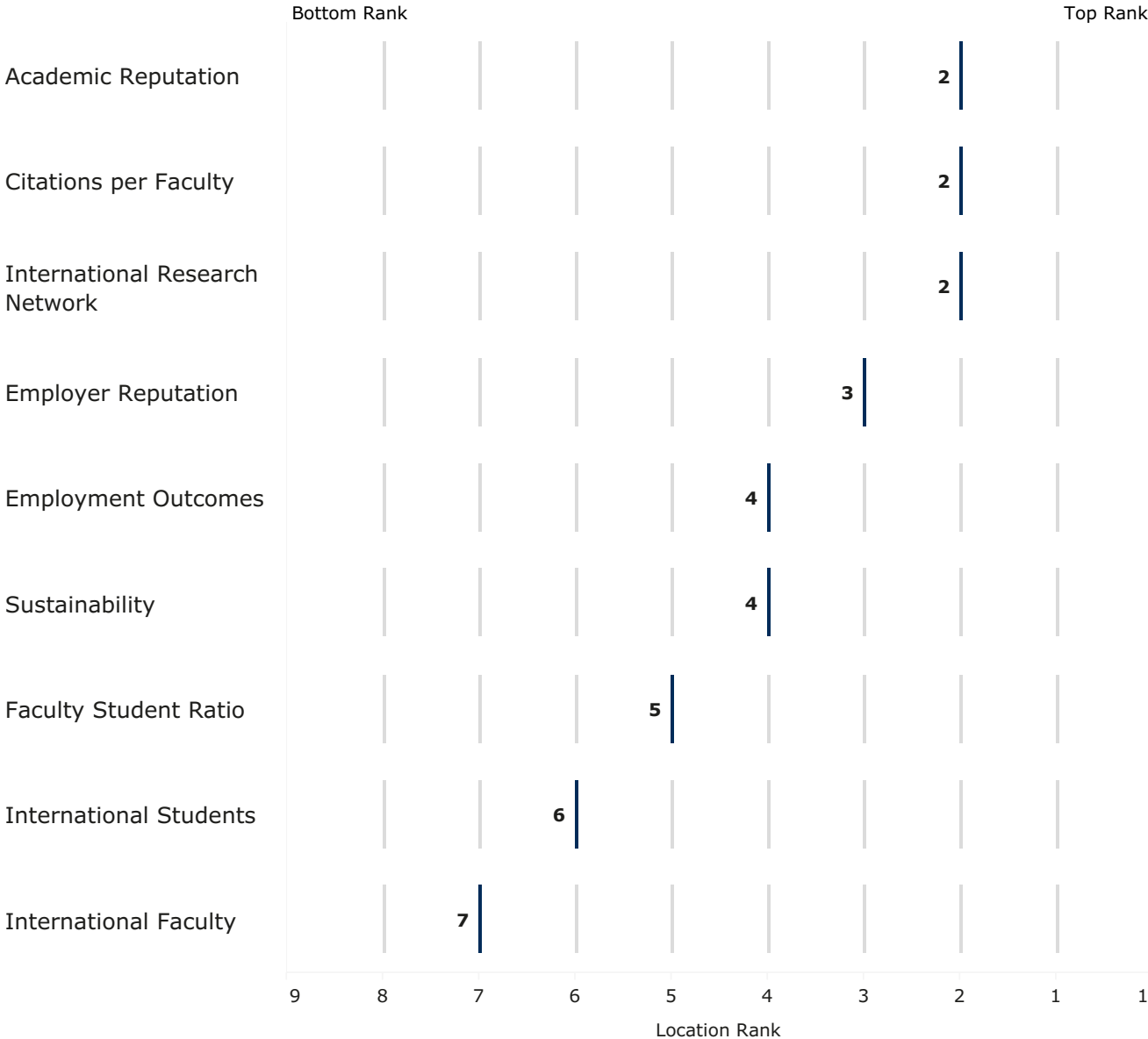

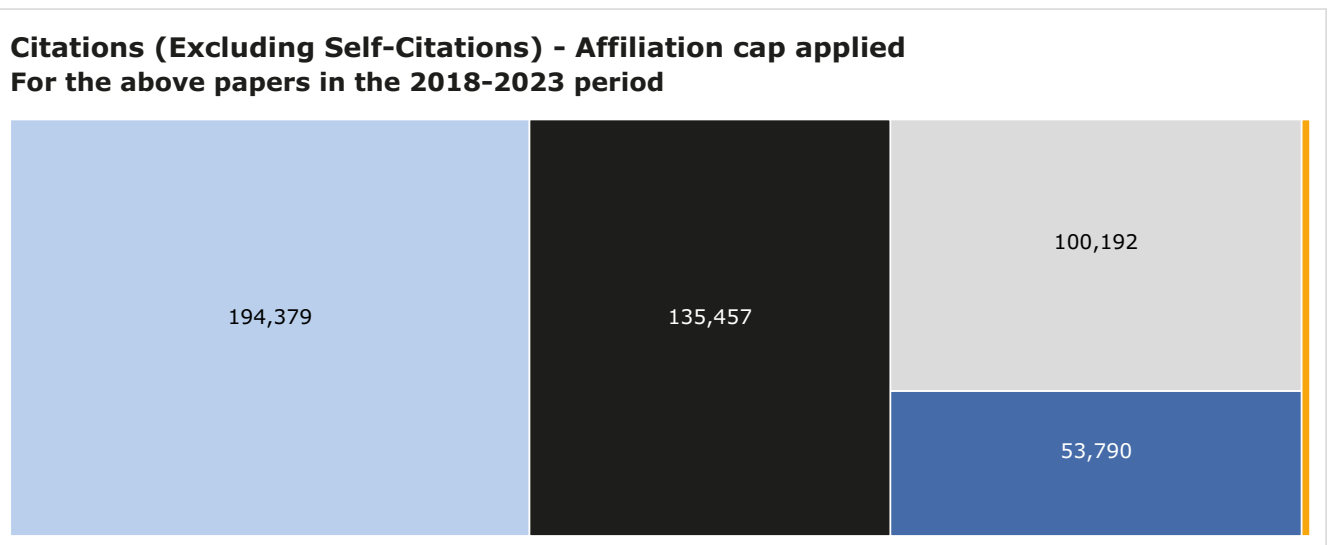
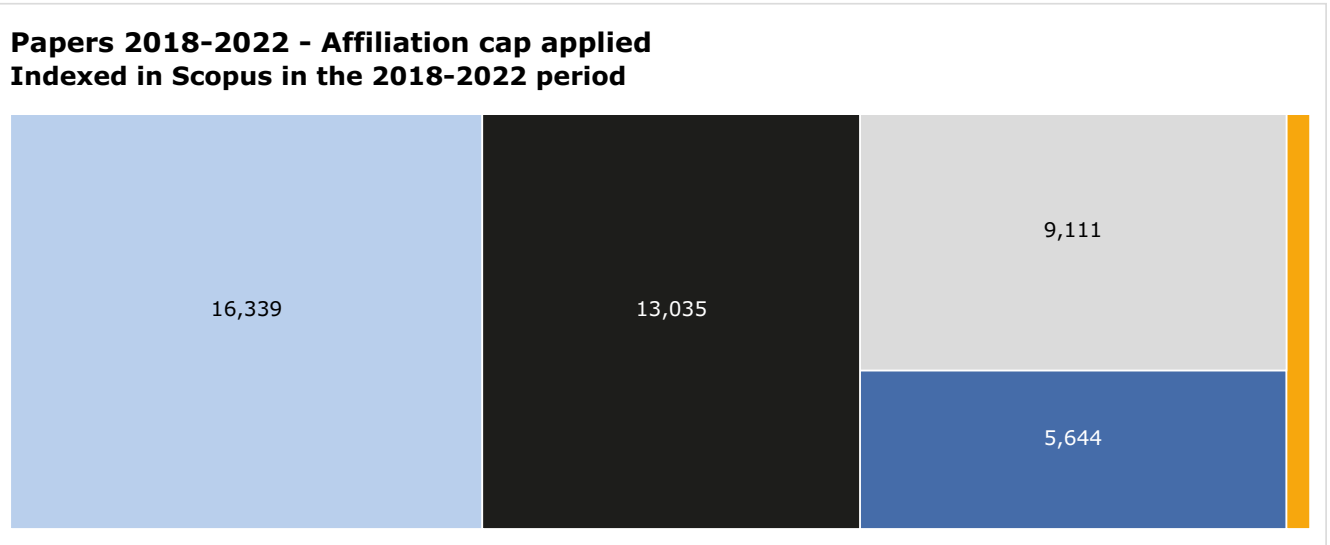

The following graphs provide the institution's breakdown of papers and citations by broad subject area indexed by Scopus and used in the 2025 edition of the rankings. QS considers six years of citations (2018-2023) for each of the five publication years (2018-2022).

The QS World University Rankings methodology utilizes a Citations per Faculty indicator and thus the objective of this approach is to derive a normalized total citation count. The primary approach is to simply equalize the influence of the five broad subject areas considered.
